



# Harvest Gasket Replacement

Kit # 94-58401

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## GASKET KIT CONTENTS:

- 5 Feet – ¼” Rope Gasket (Front Door – Small Dia. Rope)
- 3 1/2 Feet – ½” Rope Gasket (Side Door – Large Dia. Rope)
- 2 Feet – 3/8” Rope Gasket (Ash Door – Medium Dia. Rope)
- 4 1/2 Feet – ¾” Tape Gasket (Glass – Flat Gasket)
- 2 Oz Gasket Cement

## TOOLS REQUIRED:

- Scissors
- Steel Wool or Wire Brush
- Phillips Screw Driver
- Cloth Rag
- Penetrating Oil

## BEFORE YOU BEGIN:

Work on a cool stove

## PROCEDURE FOR DOOR GASKET REPLACEMENT

1. Remove the side door by lifting it straight up off the hinges with the hinge pins remaining in the door. Place it face down (Use soft surface for enameled doors).
2. Pull out used gasket from channel and discard. Clean gasket channel using steel wool or wire brush; remove any residue. Wipe clean with damp rag or cloth.
3. Cut the tip off the gasket glue bottle and apply a small bead of the adhesive to the gasket channel. Do not saturate the gasket, as this will cause the gasket to dry and harden.
4. When the adhesive becomes “tacky”, apply fresh gasket by pushing it into the channel.
  - Take care not to stretch or bunch the gasket.
  - Do not start in a corner; it will be more easily pulled out.
  - Trim any excess with the scissors
5. The door should be returned to the stove A.S.A.P. and shut tight to assure a positive seal.
6. Repeat this procedure with the front door and the ash pan door.

## PROCEDURE FOR WINDOW GASKET REPLACEMENT

**HINT:** It may be helpful to apply penetrating oil to the heads of the screws that hold the glass retention frame to the front door before attempting to remove them.

1. Remove the front door by lifting it straight up off the hinges with the hinge pins remaining in the door. Place it face down (Use soft surface for enameled doors).
2. With the phillips screw driver, remove the window frame screws to separate the window frame from the door.
3. Carefully lift the glass from the door. Pull off the worn gasket tape.
4. Peel the paper backing off the new gasket tape – a small section at a time. Wrap the tape gasket around the perimeter of the glass – overlapping the front and back of the glass edges.
5. Place the gasketed glass onto the door. .
6. Screw the window frame back on the door.
7. Install the door onto the stove.
